





The South Florida Railway Museum (SFRM) at the Deerfield Amtrak and Tri-Rail station at 1300 West Hillsboro Boulevard plans their next open house on Saturday, January 10th with visitors welcomed from 11 AM through 4 PM. Both N scale and HO scale layouts are open and on display. There are wooden trains set out on the outdoor deck to keep the small children happy, as the "look but don't touch" rules do not apply to the extremely rugged wood trains and track. The HO layout team is currently finishing up their locomotive terminal and additional scenery upgrades are also in progress. The N scale group plans to begin revamping the N scale layout in late January, so this is your last opportunity to see the current version before demolition begins.
